

#### My takeaways

- DX affects **every part** of economy and society
- **OECD supports global policymakers** by Going Digital projects
- Covid-19 has accelerated DX and part of this acceleration is like to be permanent
- Even in the same industries, COVID-19 is an opportunity for some, a challenge for others
- Japan has high potential (Internet access, math-friendly youngsters), but is not ready for DX (readiness to learn, mobile Internet)
- Government must take new approaches to policy making (review policies, set broad principles, use experimental policies and iteration, revisit policies frequently, geeks for/in government, and use data and digital tools)

## METI DX Report (Sep. 2018) – "2025 Digital Cliff"

- Business owners understand the importance of DX
- Difficulties: 1) complex and closed IT system (legacy system)
  2) unsupportive stakeholders

# **METI's DX Policies**


- **Digital Governance Code**: a guideline for management teams to follow as they seek to strategically take advantage of IT systems
- **DX Promotion Indices**: a tool to help companies diagnose current situations and challenges in their efforts for DX promotion
- **DX Certification**: METI formally recognizes DX-Ready businesses in accordance with the guideline
- DX Stock Selection: METI and Tokyo Stock Exchange jointly select DXexcellent companies



- IT/Digitalization Subsidies: subsidies to increase productivity for SMEs by installing new system
- Digitalization Supporters: matching and financial support for IT experts' consulting service for SMEs


## METI DX Report 2 (Dec. 2020)
